



Download Music to the Kindle Fire



(Streaming requires Adobe Flash which is not natively supported on the Kindle Fire)

1. At the Home Screen, press Web.
2. Type in the library's Freegal web address: freegal.mathewslibrary.org.
3. Click Login. Type in your library card number and PIN and press Login. If you do not know your PIN, see "Help with your PIN below".
4. Search for a song.
5. Press Download Now for the selected song.
6. After downloading your selection(s), press logout.
7. Press the Home button on the bottom of the screen.
8. Press the menu button.
9. Press Downloads and your song(s) should be listed.
10. Tap the song you wish to listen to.
11. You will be taken to Music, where your song(s) are listed. If your song is in the Now Playing bar at the bottom of the screen, you may remove it by pressing the Menu Button, and then, Clear Player.

These instructions may vary slightly depending on which version of the Kindle Fire you have.

Help with your PIN: The PIN required to access Freegal is the same as the password used to access your library account online. If you have not created a password for your account, click the "Library Catalog" link on the library website (www.mathewslibrary.org). Click login in the upper right corner of the library catalog. Enter your barcode number and the temporary password, "userpass". You will be presented with a dialog box where you may enter a new password. If you have forgotten your password, please ask staff to reset it for you.
