



Instructions for Using Freegal on Android Devices

1. Go to the Google Play App store and download the Freegal App.
2. After downloading, open the app, enter your location and tap Go.
3. Choose Mathews Memorial Library and login using your Mathews Memorial Library card number and PIN.
4. You can browse Top Artists, Songs, Albums, or Genres. You can also search for a specific Artist, Song, Album, or Genre by clicking on the magnifying glass.
5. To stream a song simply press the blue play arrow next to each song. You can create playlists by tapping the Playlist icon at the bottom of the screen.
6. To download a song, click on the white arrow in the black circle to start the download process.
7. Once the song has downloaded, you can play it by clicking My Music in the menu along the bottom of the screen.
8. Patrons using Freegal are entitled to download 5 titles (songs) per week. Total available songs for download is reset each Monday morning.
9. Patrons using Freegal are entitled to stream 3 hours of music daily.

Help with your PIN: The PIN required to access Freegal is the same as the password used to access your library account online. If you have not created a password for your account, click the "Library Catalog" link on the library website (www.mathewslibrary.org). Click login in the upper right corner of the library catalog. Enter your barcode number and the temporary password, "userpass". You will be presented with a dialog box where you may enter a new password. If you have forgotten your password, please ask staff to reset it for you.
